## *Directions*

In this assignment, you will be asked to visit the Rosemount House Museum in Pueblo, Colorado. The end product includes a poster that displays visual and written record of your trip to the museum.



**Location:** Rosemount is a 37-room Victorian Mansion located on the northern end of the city of Pueblo. **It is probably the finest example of a Victorian Age home in the entire state of Colorado.** The address is 419 West Fourteenth Street, Pueblo, Colorado 81002. Phone number (719) 545-5290.

**Distance:** Approximately 120 miles from Arvada.

**Admission charge:** \$6.00 per adult, \$4.00 per student. June - August: Tues. through Saturday 10:00 a.m. / last tour 3:30 p.m. Closed Mondays. September through May: Opens at 1:00 pm. instead of 10:00 a.m. Rosemount is closed during the month of January.

**(NOTE: YOU WILL NEED SOMETHING TO WRITE ON WITH YOU ON THE TOUR SO YOU CAN DRAW YOUR REQUIRED MAP(S). THE TOUR LASTS AT LEAST 45 MINUTES.**

## **PART I: SHORT ANSWER:**

1. What was the most impressive part of Rosemount in your opinion? Why?
2. Write a paragraph or so describing what your day would be like if you worked at Rosemount as a servant in 1898. (Pick a job that would have been done at the house back then.)
3. What was the name of the husband and wife that lived in the house when it was built? How did the owner make his money?
4. How many square feet in size is the house?
5. Who was the last occupant of the house who kept all the furnishings intact at the time of his death in 1968.
6. What was the single most impressive object in the house in your opinion? Explain.
7. Which room in the house was your favorite? Why?
8. Which room in the house did your parents like best? Why?
9. What is the name of the 9 by 13 foot window stained glass window on the main stair landing?
10. What was the purpose of the Butler's Pantry? What was stored there?

## **PART II: ESSAY SECTION:**

When you are done with the short answer section, write a solidly composed fourteen sentence essay on the following topic:

- ***Describe your trip to the Rosemount Museum; your tour of the house, and how it helped you better understand your Social Studies class.***

## **PART IV: POSTER:**

You are required to create a poster (poster board sized) of your trip to the Rosemount House that includes the following requirements:

1. An introductory paragraph describing your tour and advice for other students who take the same tour.
2. A "Top Five" list that lists your five favorite activities or places in the Rosemount House, with number one as the very best and on down. This list must be in clear letters that can be seen easily.
3. A hand-drawn map of the first or second floor of the house that shows all the rooms seen on the tour.
4. A visual aide section that includes at least five (5) visual aides. Visual aides could include photographs, diagrams, drawings, or three dimensional objects. Each must be clearly captioned. Each must have a clear connection to the topic
5. A "Did You Know" section that lists five statements about the Rosemount House that begins with the statement: "Did You Know..."
